

HOW TO APPLY WINDOW FILM



Each order comes complete with step-by-step fitting instructions, outlining exactly what you need to do to achieve a stunning finish. You'll also receive a free squeegee with each purchase to aid the process.

- Clean your glass thoroughly.
- Remove the backing sheet from the film.
- Use a plant spray bottle to wet the film and the glass.
- Take the film to the glass and allow it to flow into place.
- Use the squeegee to remove the remaining moisture from underneath the film.

WINDOW FILM REMOVAL



Once applied, window film can be removed and the glass returned to its original state. While there is no specific technique or tools required, the following hints and tips should help if you ever wish to remove your film.

- Sunlight can soften the adhesive; so if possible, begin the removal after the film has had some exposure to the sun.
- To begin, peel from one of the top corners and slowly pull the film away.
- Work slowly and methodically, and as always when working with glass, be careful. Do not lean on or place any extra pressure onto the glazing.
- For stubborn pieces of film, a paint scraper can be used. Make sure the scraper is sharp and take your time.
- After removing the film, some adhesive may remain on the glass. To remove this, spray with soapy water (a few drops of washing up liquid mixed with water in a plant spray bottle) and leave the affected areas to soak. Spray for a second time and then use a paint scraper to remove.
- On some occasions, after moistening, the glue can be rubbed off with a cloth.
- Once the film and any remaining residue have been removed, clean the glass with standard window cleaning products.
